

Long Range Planning Team Update

It has been a long time coming, but we are ready to start phase one of the building remodel! Much of this plan was shared in the December business meeting, but there will be a special called meeting on Sunday, February 11 at 6:00pm. This meeting will be informational in nature as all of the proper committees and teams have been working hard to ensure they have done what the church has charged them to do.

Watch your email and listen for announcement as there will be a couple opportunities to clean out downstairs areas before work starts on February 12.

In short, phase one will include:

- -Opening the current Welcome Center Entrance by removing the rooms on either side of the door.
- -Removing the wallpaper and wood paneling in the back hallway.
- -New flooring and paint in the entire old, downstairs wing.
- -Expanding a couple of adult classrooms.
- -Rehabbing the back hallway bathrooms.

The \$170,000 received from TPC and money from the material contingency account, which has been saved for building upgrades, will fund this project. The church is not taking on debt for this project.
